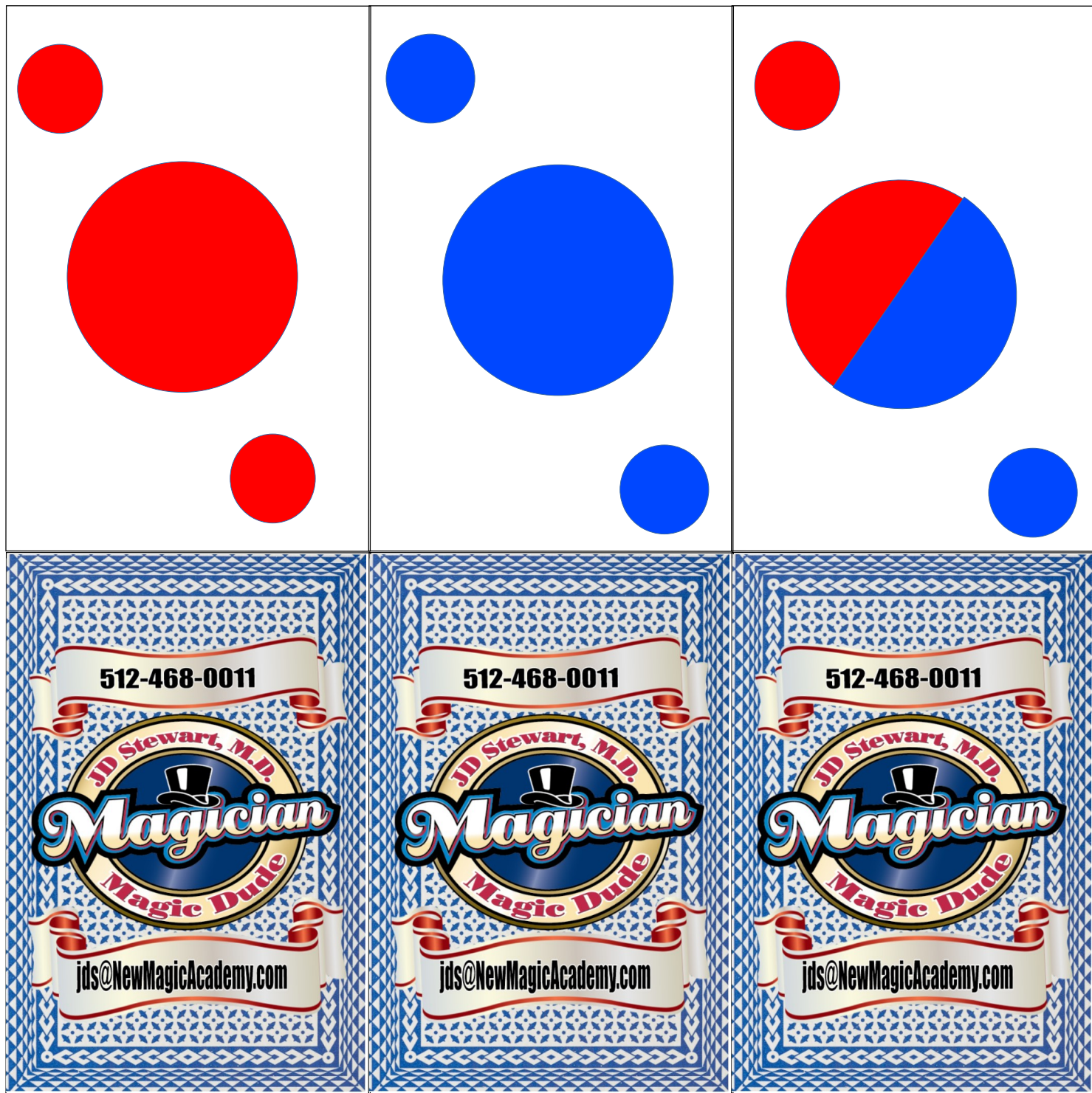

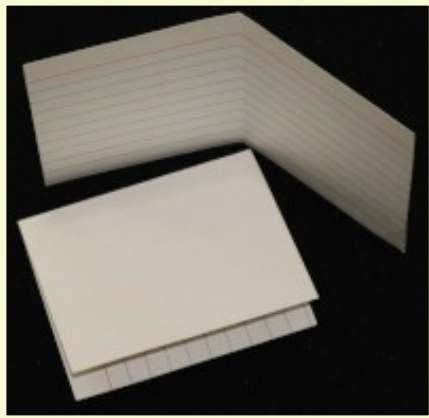

Linking Cards

Making Instructions

You Will Need

- 2 Index or post cards.



Step 1

Fold the index or post card in half.

Step 2

Tear the center out of each card



Step 3

Open up both cards and secretly tear the one edge of one of the cards at the fold.



Color Changing Cards

Making Instructions



You Will Need

- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Print out of color changing cards

Step 1

Cut out the color changing cards. Cut them out so the front (dots) and the back are one piece



Step 2

Fold the front and back together so you can see both of them. Glue the front to the back.



Genie Cards

Making Instructions

You Will Need

- Rubber band the ones they put around broccoli work best
- Printed copies of the Genie cards
- Scissors



Step 1

Print several sheets of the Genie cards. It works best if the cards are printed on a heavier stock of paper than regular printer paper.

Step 2

Cut out the individual cards.
Fold 1 card in half.



Step 3

Stack the cards together. Place the half card on top. Wrap the rubber band around the stack so no one can tell the top card is only a half card.
