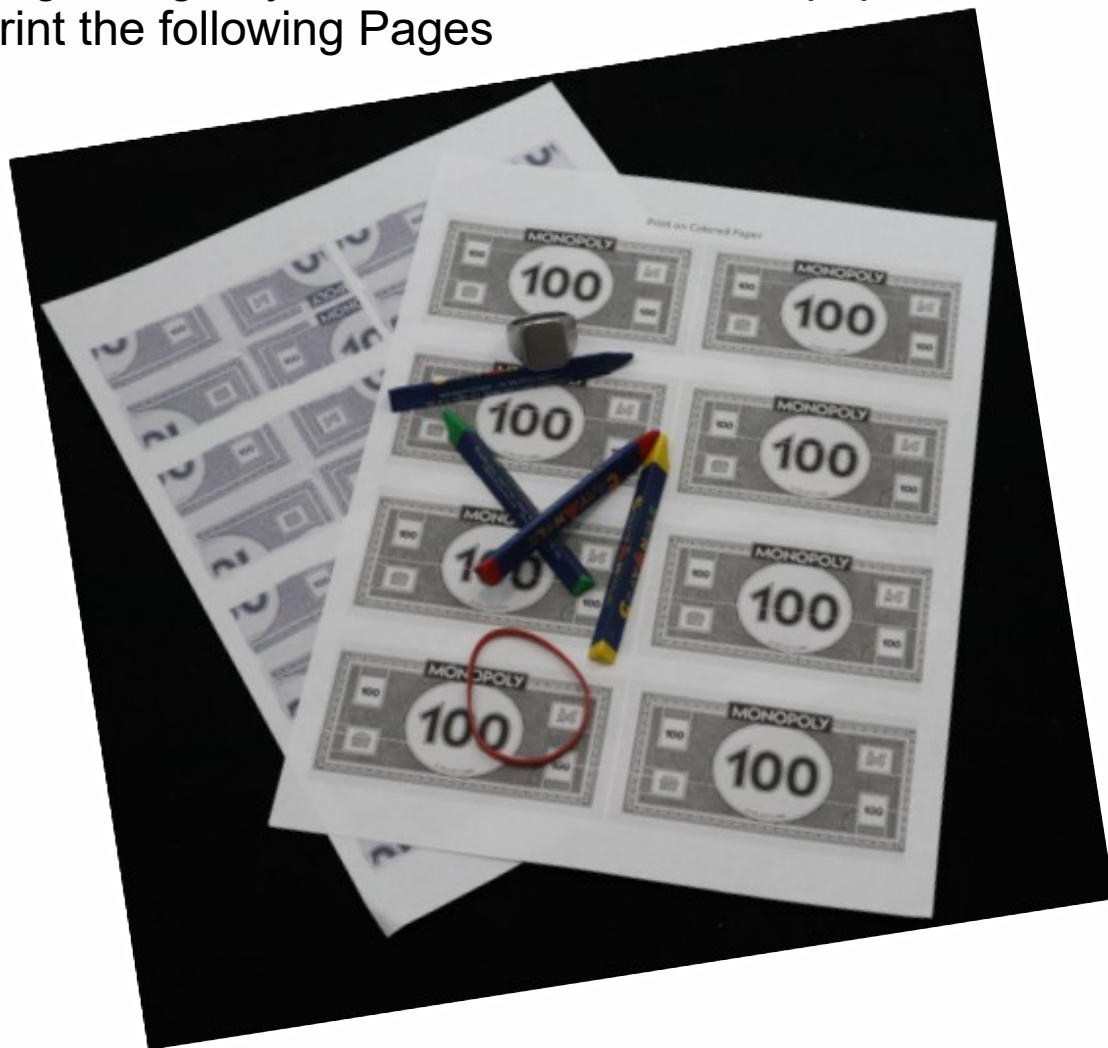


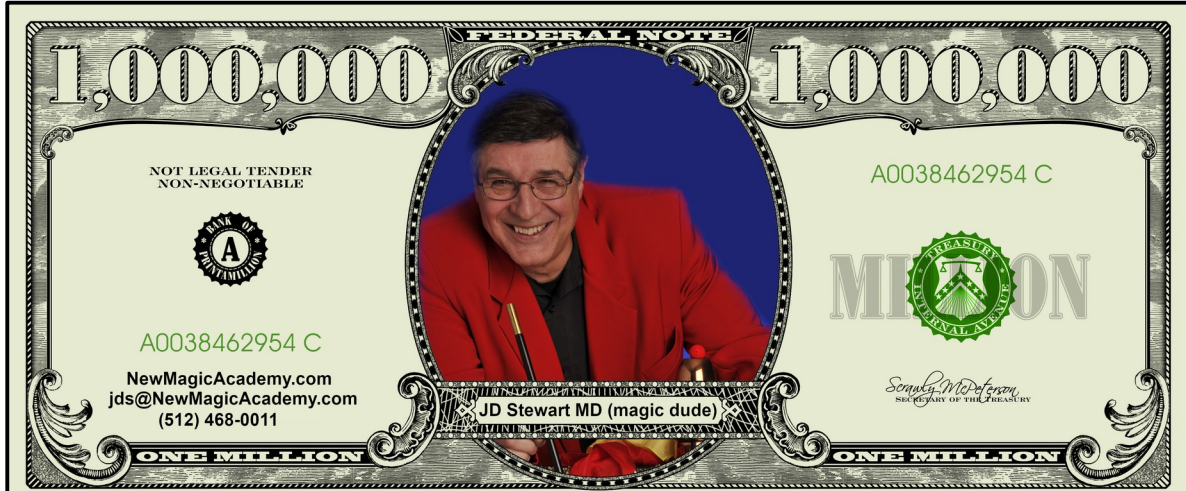

Try combination different things. Ask yourself what if it were bigger, smaller, fancier, from the past or future, What if it were edible.

Pick A Card

Effect: A selected card is revealed in a fun way.

Secret: a "Key Card" is used. The key card is a card you remember and it helps you find any selected card.

Preparation:

Place you keycard on the bottom of the deck. We'll use the Aces of spades

Presentation:

1. Explain you want them to select any card and remember it.
2. Once they selected the card put the deck on the table. Have them put their card on top of the deck.
3. Have them take a stack of cards off the deck and put the remaining cards on top of their stack. Your key card the Ace of Spade is now on top of their card.
4. To find their card pick up the deck and look for you key card. The card on top of your key card is their card.
5. Now reveal it in any creative way.
